



Dr. Amgad Albohy is a lecturer of Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Faculty of Pharmacy, Ain Shams University. He got his PhD in Chemical Biology from the University of Alberta, Canada and was working at the Alberta Glycomics Centre. He was trained in both Friedrich Schiller University in Germany and the Complex Carbohydrate Research Center (CCRC), University of Georgia, USA.

Dr. Albohy's research focuses on the design of selective inhibitors among closely related isozymes. He worked in the design of inhibitors targeting human sialidases and cyclooxygenases. He is also interested in protein expression, enzyme assays development and optimization, enzyme kinetics and STD NMR.
